These centres provide valuable, cost-free support and resources for parents and families with children aged 0 to 8 years old, with a particular emphasis on the critical developmental years of ages 0-4 years.

The Centres help ensure that children have the best start in life by providing a range of easily accessible programs and services for families, including early learning programs, maternal and child health services, developmental delay support, as well as parent education and support programs.

Services

The Centres are a resource for the whole community offering a wide range of services for children and their families, including:

- ★ Kindergarten readiness programs
- ★ Playgroups
- ★ Sensory, Music & Movement programs
- ★ Circle of Security Workshops
- ★ Child Health Checks
- ★ School holiday activities
- ★ Parenting information and programs
- ★ Speech and Language programs
- ★ Occupational Therapy programs
- ★ Parent seminars on topics such as healthy eating, first aid, child behaviour management strategies.

Playgroups and Educational Programs

Playgroups facilitated at the Centres are tailored to the developmental needs identified for children in that specific location. The Child and Parent Centres offer a range of educational programs for families. Kindergarten readiness programs are available to help children make a smooth and successful transition into school. Parent Support Groups provide a welcoming space for families to connect and build social networks. Feedback and ideas from local families in the community are always welcome.

Referrals

Our Centres offer Child Health Nurse services for child developmental checks through Child and Adolescent Community Health, and referrals to a Child Development Service Speech Pathologist for language and communication support.

We also offer access to advice from our Occupational Therapist, and connections to other agencies offering counselling and family support services.
