Parkerville Children and Youth Care's Reconnect program is a community based early intervention and prevention service for young people aged 12 to 18 years who are experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness, and encourages them to stay connected with family and the community.

Reconnect assists young people to stabilise their living situation and improve their level of engagement with family, work, education, training and their local community

Services

The Parkerville Children and Youth Care Reconnect program staff can assist young people and their parents and/or carers to:

- Better understand each other's views, expectations and boundaries
- Work together to re-build and strengthen family relationships
- Re-engage with school, or if appropriate, assist with access to alternative education, training or employment
- Increase contact with safe and supportive family, social and community networks
- Create links with other support services to address a range of health, financial and other needs
- Refer to other relevant Parkerville Children and Youth Care programs

Referrals

Referrals to the Reconnect program can be made by young people, parents, carers, schools, or other agencies.

Outreach

Reconnect is an outreach program where our team will visit a young person or family. We aim to be as flexible as possible. Some may like to catch up at home, a coffee shop, school or in a park, wherever they feel most comfortable. If you are a parent, we are happy to catch up during your lunch break at work, or at home after hours, whatever is convenient for you

Cost

This service is FREE and voluntary.

What to do in a crisis

The Reconnect program is available Monday to Friday from 9am to 5pm.

If you find yourself in a crisis situation, please contact Crisis Care on (08) 9223 1111.

This phone line operates 24 hours, 7 days a week and is an information and counselling service for people in crisis needing urgent help.
