Services Provided

Support and Counselling Services aims to bring about sustainable, long-term change within the family to prevent future homelessness.

This is achieved by supporting the family through tailored interventions to address their physical, emotional, therapeutic, practical, and recreational needs.

Support and Counselling Services are split into three sub-groups: Therapeutic Support, Family Support and Recreational Support.

Service activities are individualised and flexible, to meet the changing needs of families. Support and Counselling Services empower families to access appropriate services in the future to prevent and break the cycle of homelessness.



Therapeutic Support

This includes:

Individual mentoring

Group support sessions

Provision of the Protective Behaviours program and other tailored groups

Referrals made to specialist therapeutic support services where appropriate.

Family Support

This includes:

Outreach support

Educational support

Court and justice support

Health support

Referrals to other services, where necessary.

Recreational Support

This includes:

Linking to sporting activities

Linking to community groups or neighbourhood programs

Linking to social activities and groups
